MATHEMATICS
 We are learning to understand decimals, percentages and algebra, geometry and arithmetic. We will also be revising addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.

 We aim to understand computer networks including the internet, how they can provide multiple Services- such as the world wide web; and the opportunities they offer for Communication and collaboration




MUSIC

 We will be looking at the physical geography of Central America, looking at the volcanic activity and the importance of the rainforest.



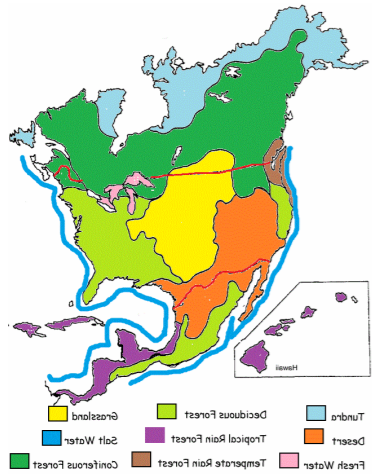
ENGLISH

 We will be comparing Central America Cultures from c900 to British culture. We will explore religious beliefs, customs, societal hierarchies and daily life.




SCIENCE
