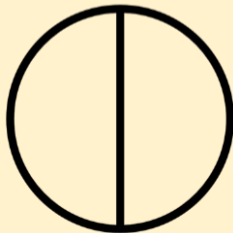
Do you know the colour wheel and how colours are organised?

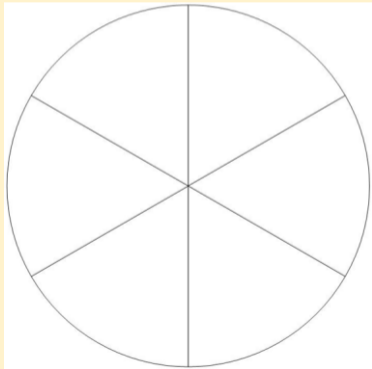
## Colour Wheel Collage

On a piece of A4 white paper draw out a big circle. Find something you can draw around to make a perfect circle (a small plate would be good!)

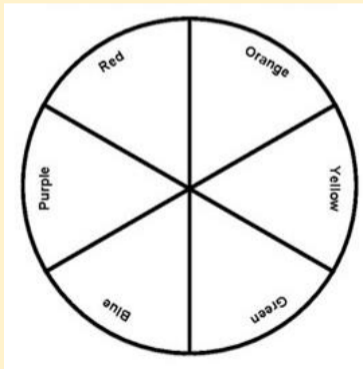
Next, use a ruler to draw down the middle of your circle. It should look like this.



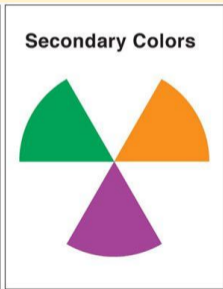
Next, you need to add two more lines to make a complete colour wheel. Try your best to make each section equal. You should have six sections!



Now for the fun bit! Instead of colouring in your colour wheel with paint, I would like you to use **old magazines or coloured paper to create a collage**. Try to go up to the line so that there is no white space left.



You can start with any colour you like, but remember to get them in the correct order. Maybe you could teach your parents about the primary and secondary colours!



Your finished colour wheel should look something like this. Try to find different shades for each colour, for example light blue and dark blue. You might like to write the name of each colour too. Have fun!
