Remember to use strategies to make meaning.

- Read the text carefully a few times.
- Look for known words. (The text is full of previously learnt vocabulary)
- Look for cognates. (A word that looks and sound the same in Spanish and English and often means the same)
- Use an online bilingual dictionary to find out the meaning of unfamiliar words. (Yes there are some. Remember you need to streeeeetch your vocabulary!)
- Look at the illustrations/ pictures. They will give you clues about what the text is about.

Use your knowledge and skills to understand the text.
