At Leopold Primary School, we enhance our Early Years curriculum in a variety of fun and engaging ways.

We provide opportunities to explore the wider world through our curriculum planning for People, Culture and Communities and The Natural World. This includes trips to the post office, the local park and to local care centre where children interact positively with members of the community. We also have visitors who run bespoke sessions in school. This includes art, theatre and drama workshops and visits from members of the community such the local fire brigade, animal and wildlife services and local authors.
