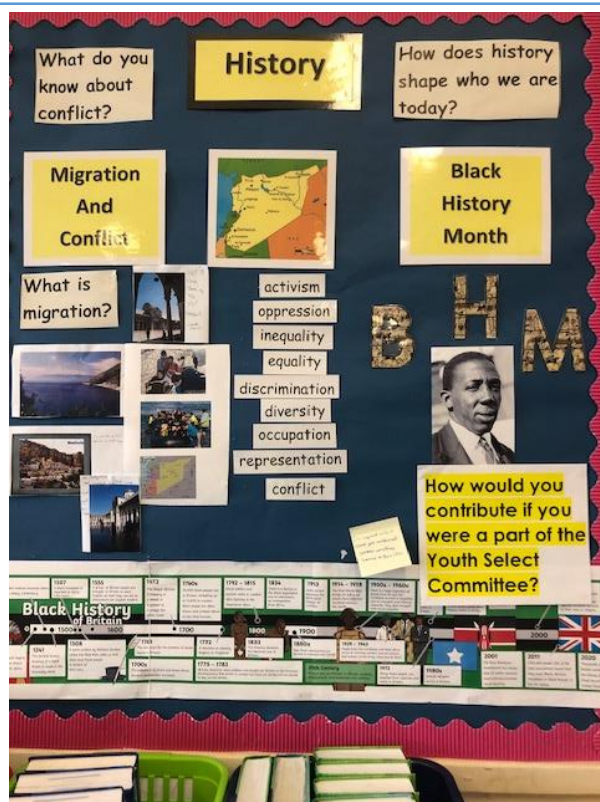
Enrichment
