
Curriculum Overview

MATHS Place value and number ENGLISH Claude in the City and Rapunzel




Over the half term in Maths we will be covering place value and number. The children will be building on existing knowledge of counting forwards and backwards, to and through 100. They will

continue to practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. They will be recognising numbers in numerals and words and representing numbers in various abstract and pictorial ways. We will be comparing and ordering numbers and beginning to explain our reasoning for an answer.



This half term in English we will be studying 'Claude in the city'. The children will develop their oracy skills through Talk for Writing lessons, along with grammar input. They will use the skills they have learned to write a letter, newspaper report and informative text based on the book.



In the latter part of the half term, we will be studying 'Rapunzel'. They will continue to develop their oracy skills through Talk for Writing. Their writing skills will be developed through creating a narrative story and instructions.
