



MATHS		Geography		
<p>Statistics, Algebra and consolidation</p> <p>We will be consolidating our maths topics from year 6 with problem solving scenarios and maths projects so that the children can continue to use and revise all their mathematical skills within various contexts.</p> 		<p>Home and Away: How do Brazil and the UK compare?</p> <p>In this unit, children will describe the geographical location of Brazil using key terminology, such as "Southern Hemisphere", "South America", "Equator", describe the environmental regions of Brazil, comparing deserts to rainforests to grasslands, and contrast those with environmental regions of the UK and understand that Brazil has the highest number of uncontacted tribes in the world. They will also compare the life of a child in the UK (themselves) to that of a child from the Awa tribe</p>
