### **MATHS**

# This half term in maths we will be learning about time and shape. The children will be


The children will also be learning about 3-D shapes and they will have a go at making 3-D shapes in class.

## **GEOGRAPHY**

#### **Home and Away**

This half term the children will be making comparisons between the UK and China. They will use digital mapping to locate China and the UK and compare their geographic location. The children will explore the history and essence of trade (Silk Road) and what products China and UK export/import and the impact of this industry on each country's economy.

They will also have the opportunity to compare the human geography of China and the UK, by learning about and present differences in the population of China and the UK.



#### **ENGLISH**

# In English this term, children will be exploring 'The Hundred-Mile An- Hour Dog' by Jeremy Strong.

They will be learning a variety of writing genres including haiku poems and newspaper articles. The children will expand on their knowledge and be able to write fronted adverbials, alliteration and conjunctions.



#### **MUSIC**

This half term the children will learn how to explain and express an opinion of Indian music. They will learn how the tempo and dynamics vary as well as which instruments are used in Indian music.

They will read musical notation and play the correct notes of the rag.



# PSHE Changes

#### RE

The children will investigate the purpose of real and imaginary computer simulations.

## **SCIENCE**

#### **Rocks**

This term, children will identify and describe the functions of different types of rocks and soil. They will be identifying and investigating the difference between natural and human-made rocks, learning about the 3 types of naturally occurring rock. As well as understanding that fossils tell us what has happened before (they give us evidence) and show that living things have changed over time. Understanding fossils are most commonly found in sedimentary rock. Palaeontologists use Fossils to find out about the past. They will be introduced to soil being the uppermost layer of the earth and is made up of different things.
