## Enrichment



At Leopold Primary School, we value hands-on experiences in the teaching of Geography. Our children are provided with contemporary learning opportunities, such as the chance to manipulate 3D models of concepts difficult to imagine, e.g. world biomes, time zones, volcanoes, etc using Mozaik 3D software. Google Earth is also used for navigation and map reading purposes.



We also have an annual subscription to Digimap – a mapping software that allows us to access detailed maps of the whole world, map out our journeys and compare maps of the same areas in different time periods to track trends and changes to our environment.

At both sites, we have a dedicated team of Eco Warriors, whose goal is to make our school and the environment more sustainable.

To inspire wonder and love for Geography, we hold thematic days, such as Earth Hour morning and Culture Day, where children are immersed in versatile experiences, such as food tasting and art appreciation of different countries.

Leopold children also take part in fieldwork and trips, where learning is taken outside the four walls of the classroom and put into real-life context.
