Heat Safety Water Balloon Activity

Children will learn about, or reinforce prior learning about, evaporation and how to stay cool and safe in heat and strong sun. Drying off after this activity will practically demonstrate the effects of evaporation on their clothes. It will also serve as a team-building exercise to prepare them for their new classes in the upcoming school year.
