End of Key Stage 1 Assessments

Dear Parents and Carers,

As I am sure you are aware, we are required by the Department of Education to submit assessment levels for our Year 2 children at the end of the academic year. In order to make these judgments, the class teachers use the work the children have completed in their books, their knowledge of what children can do and 'End of Key Stage Assessments', known as SATs.

The children are assessed in Reading, Writing and Maths. This is a combination of work in class and small work outside the class.

We make the assessments as fun as possible and will explain to the children that they provide them with the opportunity to share their knowledge and demonstrate all the hard work and excellent learning that they have done this year.

Q. How can you help your child to prepare?

A. We will make sure all pupils are prepared. There's nothing specifically test-related that you should do to prepare your child, but please do keep completing the maths home learning, practicing their times tables and reading with them daily.
