This term we will be learning about settlements. Children will extend their knowledge on what a settlement is and how many different types of settlements there are.



RSE


As part of their RSE learning this term, children will be exploring how to be respectful with each other, how words can be hurtful and what is considered a healthy and an unhealthy relationship.
