I am writing to remind you about the year six residential which is booked from Wednesday 5th July until Friday 7th July 2023. The children will be based at a site called Marchants Hill, in Surrey. We will travel there on Wednesday by coach and return on Friday afternoon.

Outward Journey Wednesday: Depart at 2pm – arrival time at Marchants Hill 3:30pm

Inward Journey Friday: Coach will leave Marchants Hill at 2pm and arrive back at school at 3:30pm

Trousers or leggings

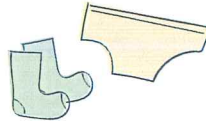
but not jeans as they get heavy and cold when wet
