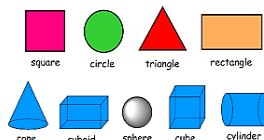


MATHS

Addition -Subtraction - Shapes

This half term children will learn how to add one - digit and two - digit numbers using a number line and base ten resources.



Children will also learn to recognise both standard and non-standard representations of 2-D and 3-D shapes. For example, they should notice that there is no such thing as an 'upside down triangle'; instead, it is just a triangle in a different orientation.

ENGLISH

Toby and The Great Fire of London/The Dark



This half term in English we will be studying two exciting books. 'Toby and the Great Fire of London' by Margaret Nash and Jane Cope. This book is based on a true story but with made up characters. The subject, The Great Fire of London broke out on 2nd September 1666. We will also be reading 'The Dark' by Lemony Snickett. This is a story of courage as Laszlo stops being afraid of the dark. The children will continue to develop their oracy skills

through Talk for Writing lessons, along with grammar input. They will use the skills they have learned to write a letter, narrative, diary entry and informative text based on the books.



Geography

Countries that make up the UK



Children will begin to explore their local environment and review the four countries of the UK, which they would have learnt about in Year 1. They build onto this by introducing comparisons and in-depth studies of each country to promote a sense of pride and belonging.

RSE

Families and People Who Care for Me



This half term Y2 will be covering topics about their families, different types of families and to understand what type of physical contact is safe, an acceptable.

DT

A Balanced Diet

Children will learn about healthy eating and a balance diet. At the end of this unit children will make a healthy wrap.



PE

Invasion – Tag Rugby

Children will be learning how to change their running speed while avoiding obstacles and holding a large ball. They will also learn how to make tackle with a tag belt.



RE

How do people show their beliefs?

This term, children will learn about how religions show and express their beliefs about God. They will be able to identify and recognise different symbols and what they represent in various religions.

The children will learn songs which will be played on violins. Development of oral awareness and musical literacy using Sol Fa.



SCIENCE

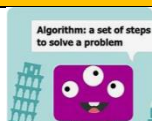
Living things
