SCIENCE

In science we are going to be learning about LIGHT. Our focus is on Light sources, darkness being the absence of light and how shadows form.

Some key questions for you to think about.....

What is a light source?

Why do we need light?

How are shadows formed?

Are all surfaces reflective?



We have posted a knowledge organizer on seesaw to help you and will post lessons and activities. Will include: making shadow puppets, mirror writing, creating rainbows by refracting light on bubbles or with CDs/DVDs
