MATHEMATICS

Children will be focusing on counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, solving word problems, telling the time, measuring and counting money.



COMPUTING



Children will use Purple Mash to start simple coding.

GEOGRAPHY

Maps

Pupils will start reading maps and they will design their own map for a perfect garden.



ENGLISH

Reading

Children will be focusing on their reading skills such as, comprehension, understanding and explaining the meaning of new words, inferring and predicting what might happen next.



Writing

Children will plan, write and edit their own lists, letters, diary entries, settings and characters' descriptions based on our class stories.

Pupils will press and print leaves and flowers.

They will learn how to create secondary colours. They will use a range of technics to make marks and patterns in the style of Henry Matisse.
