

Curriculum Overview

We hope that this information will give you an understanding of what your child is learning this term and we encourage your involvement.

MATHEMATICS

In maths we will be focusing on time, money and measurement. Children will have the opportunity to look at different ways of measuring while they are at home, and different ways to count time and money.

COMPUTING

We are continuing our learning of computer programming while exploring online safety and algorithms using Purple mash.



MUSIC

We will be focusing on rhythm and notes in music. Please see the announcement that was posted on Seesaw regarding teaching your child music at home.



GEOGRAPHY

We will be focusing on Kenya this half term. We will learn where Kenya is, what its climate is, what animals live there, and so much more!
