
Curriculum Overview

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

How do people show their beliefs?

In this unit children will become acquainted with worn symbols of belonging in different religions and begin to identify the meaning of, and the beliefs about God that these symbolic items show.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

We will be working on mastering basic movements, gain confidence and participate in group activities/games.

- Have your child write about what they did at school in a journal each day to improve their writing skills.


PSHE
