

Year 5 Information



Dear Parents and carers,

Welcome back to school! The Year 5 team hopes you have had a restful and healthy time over the holiday. We are looking forward to a fun term full of exciting learning opportunities in a safe learning environment. We would like to give you the following information, which will support your child's learning.

Reading Books

Children need to be reading 20 minutes every night at home. We encourage them to read books that are at home but will offer children books to take home from class if they require them. Listen to your child reading out loud and asking "why?" -based questions about what they have read to support the development of their comprehension skills. Please make sure reading records are completed every evening and brought to school every day.

Homework

Homework will be given out every Friday and should be submitted the following Tuesday. We will continue using Seesaw to communicate which homework is to be completed. It needs to be completed to a high standard and on time. Children will also be given weekly spelling tests for which they need to practice and write sentences for each word to show they understand the meaning. As well as this they should be practicing their times tables and using Mathletics.

School Uniform

Please ensure that your child wears the correct school uniform every day. Every item of clothing must have their name written inside.
