### **Attendance and Punctuality**

Attendance and punctuality is a priority for all children. School begins at 8.30am for Reception and 8.45am for Nursery. The school day ends at 3.00pm for Nursery and 3.15pm for Reception. Please ensure you drop off and pick up your child promptly.

### **Breakfast Club**

Breakfast club is available for all pupils from Nursery to Year 6 and runs from 8.00am until class starts. The cost for the service is £1 per day.

### **PE**

PE is on Monday for Nursery and Tuesday for Reception. Please be reminded that children should wear appropriate footwear on this day.

### **Reading Books**

Children need to be reading every night at home. Your child will soon be bringing home a library book and a reading scheme book to read with you at home. Please record a written note in the reading record each day. Books should be brought to school daily in a book bag in order for class teachers to read in school with the children also.

Please listen to your child reading aloud and ask questions about what they have read to support the development of their comprehension skills.

If a reading book is lost or damaged, £5.00 will need to be paid to the school to replace it.

### **Traditional Tales**

This term we will be reading traditional tales, such as The Three Little Pigs, Goldilocks and the Three Bears, The Three Billy Goats Gruff and Little Red Riding Hood. If possible, please read these stories at home to consolidate learning and recall.

### **Homework**

Homework will continue to be issued every Friday. It should be completed to a high standard and submitted by the following Tuesday at the latest. Further information and updates will be provided by the class teacher.

### **School Uniform**

Please ensure that your child wears full school uniform every day. Jumpers should be clearly labelled with your child's name. Please also remind children of the importance of caring for their own belongings and placing jumpers etc. on their pegs upon removal. Children can bring a water bottle to school each day. This should also be labelled with your child's name.
