Literacy



As Readers, we will be:

- Beginning to read words and simple sentences
- Using vocabulary that is influenced by the books we have read

As Writers, we will be:

- Beginning to write simple sentences such as 'the cat is fat'

Physical Development



As Movers and Handlers, we will be:

- Adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles
- Forming recognisable letters

As Self-Carers, we will be:

- Practising some appropriate safety measures without direct supervision

Communication and Language



As Listeners, we will be:

- Anticipating key events in the stories we are reading
- Understanding humour, such as nonsense rhymes and jokes

As Speakers, we will be:

- Extending vocabulary by exploring the meaning and sounds of new words

As Mathematicians, we will be:

- Finding the total numbers of items in two groups by counting all of them
- Beginning to use the vocabulary involved in addition
- Solving addition and doubling number problems using concrete materials
