

Curriculum Overview

We hope that this information will give you an understanding of what your child is learning at school and we encourage your involvement.

MATHEMATICS

We are learning to multiply large numbers using formal columnar methods and to divide using the short and long division methods.

History

We will be learning about Romans through artefacts and primary and secondary sources. We will develop our critical thinking by comparing conflicting historical accounts and will examine the legacy of the Romans in Britain today.



English



Our core texts in English will be "Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone", focusing on descriptive writing and narrative building.

Reading

We will be reading fiction and non-fiction books. We are learning to infer meaning from more complex texts, and ask deeper questions about the authors writing. For online access, we will be using Bug Club.



COMPUTING

Children will be creating spreadsheets and writing for a specific audience. They will be using 2Calculate and 2Simulate on Purple Mash.

Children will be supported by Brent Music Service and class teachers during music lessons.
