Reading Books

Please listen to your child reading out loud and ask questions about what they have read to support the development of their comprehension skills. Homework

Homework will continue to be given every Friday. It needs to be completed to a high standard and returned the following Wednesday. Children will also be given weekly spelling tests for which they need to practice and write sentences for each word to show they understand the meaning. Many children were not completing the sentences last half term so please encourage this. As well as this they should be practicing their 2, 5 and 10 times tables and using IXL regularly.
