Zoolab Naturetown: <u>Tuesday 1 June 2.00 – 3.00pm</u>

As always, ZooLab has a tale in store to inspire the next generation of readers, storytellers and environmentalists. 'Naturetown' is not just a story but a rhyming adventure, following eco-warriors in a crusade to help their local wildlife. This tale investigates issues of plastic pollution, deforestation and litter; teaching us about alternatives such as recycling, composting and habitat creations, to reinforce what we can do to protect and care for our animal neighbours. This virtual event will include live animals such as: stick insects, tarantula, scorpion, corn snake, giant millipedes, cockroaches, giant African land snail, tree frog, rat. The animals used on the day may vary slightly. For ages 5 - 11.

Baby Goz with Steve Weatherill Wednesday 2 June 11.00am - 12.30pm

Author and illustrator Steve Weatherill introduces Baby Goz and the Bitey Book adventure. Plus he will share how to draw Goz and other animals from his stories including dinosaurs! For ages 5 – 7+.



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Zoolab Rainforest: Thursday 3 June 11.30am - 12.30pm

Children get to go on a journey through the rainforest - with real rainforest animals and a ranger who really knows the rainforest inside out. It's all about experiencing the drama of the rainforest - from the dark forest floor to the dizzy heights of the emergent layer!

Children will learn about plants and get to meet a range of animals from ground-dwelling snails, 'travelling' snakes and canopy-dwelling tree frogs! They'll get to learn all about the layer(s) in which they live, who and what they eat, how they operate in different light levels, and all about life in the steamy tropics. And they'll learn about rainforest location, rainfall and weather and rainforest destruction. This virtual event will include live animals such as: stick insects, tarantula, scorpion, corn snake, giant millipedes, cockroaches, giant African land snail, tree frog, rat. The animals used on the day may vary slightly. For ages 5 - 11.
