The children took part in a transition morning on Monday 19th July. We welcomed the new teachers and they all took part in activities together. The children are excited to start a new term as are we.

Breakfast club and after school club

In the autumn term, we will open our clubs again and are in the process of securing a new provider. We hope to open by the half term or sooner. We will update parents as soon as more information becomes available.

Pupil lunches

As of September 2021, there will be changes to our debt policy. Should there be an outstanding debt for school lunches greater than £21.00 (two weeks' worth of lunches) children will be provided with a nutritional packed lunch instead of a hot meal. This will consist of a sandwich, water and fruit. This change aims to ensure parents pay for their children's lunches in advance and do not incur a debt that becomes unaffordable. This action has needed to be taken due to the large amount of debt parents currently owe to the school.

If debts are incurred, then the school budget has to pay for them. This means that money which should be spent on the children's education is used to pay for debts incurred by parents. Every parent will agree that this is unacceptable and we request that all parents give this change their full support.

If you cannot afford to pay for school lunches, you can apply for free school meals (please see our website for more information) or provide your child with a packed lunch. If you are experiencing financial difficulties, please contact the office and speak to our parent liaison officer Ms Primus.

We hope this change can make a positive impact.

Brent Council has received funding from the Department for Education to deliver a Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme in 2021, as part of a national scheme. The aim of the programme is to support the physical and mental health and wellbeing of children and young people, encouraging them to engage in interactive and fun activities.

The programme will offer free places at holiday provision in the Easter, summer and Christmas school holidays in 2021 for school-aged children in Brent (aged 4-16) who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals.

Holiday provision can also be open to children not eligible for free school meals, but participation may not be funded through the government grant. If you think your child may be eligible to access a free place but they are not in receipt of free school meals, please discuss this with your child's school.
