My focus this week has been humanities and I have observed history lessons across the school. Mrs Garland our history lead observed with me, together with the head of schools.

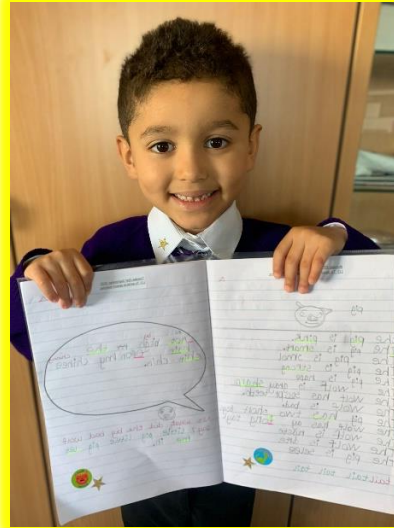
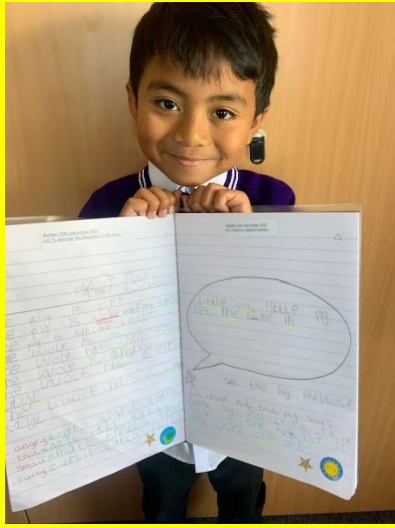
If you haven't already done so, please take your children to the library and withdraw books on their history topic. This will improve their knowledge in the specific areas they are studying.
