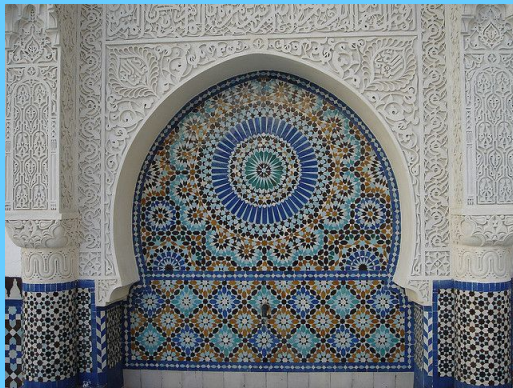
In RE, I have enjoyed learning about different religions such as Judaism, Christianity and Islam. We have been looking at how Christians and Jewish people are forgiven for their sins.

Year 2 will be looking at how Islamic art helps Muslims show their beliefs. They will also be designing and creating their own mosaic for a water garden in a Mosque.



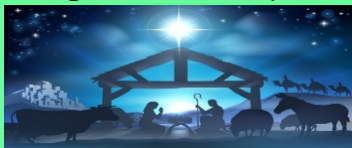
Year 3 have been learning all about places of worship in different religions.
