Genesis impact is charitable organisation with a focus on strengthening communities through educational development, preparing young people to make a positive impact in their communities and supporting parents to achieve their full potential to foster family unity. Since our inception, Genesis Impact has worked with over 5000 families in schools settings and the B.A.M.E community. We work in the most deprived areas in Greenwich and Bexley. Consequently, our beneficiaries have extremely high adult and child safeguarding needs.



Our Aim

Our core aim is the Strengthen Communities. From our days as a youth club, we realised there are four essential factors required for children to thrive. The four factors to produce Happy Children are a Happy Home; a Community; Education; and a Future. We have developed this into our Happy Child Model, which succinctly communicates our approach to strengthening communities.

Our Model



HAPPY HOME

We develop the knowledge, skills, and holistic wellbeing of parents to produce happy parents who will be empowered to rear happy children.



COMMUNITY

We build trust and awareness between local agencies and beneficiaries to ensure vulnerable families do not fall through the net.



EDUCATION

We improve employment prospects and enterprise skills, to improve the economic standing of families and children



FUTURE

We nurture the potential of young people from disadvantaged backgrounds and ensure that no hurdle is too high

Our focus is not just on short term solutions but also on long term lasting impact.
