| <p>Multiplication and Division</p> <p>Children are learning how to multiply a two-digit number by a one-digit number, such as 45 x 3, using a range of mental and informal methods. They will use objects, drawings, diagrams and formal written methods.</p>  | | <p>The Indus Valley</p> <p>This term in History, children will continue to learn about ancient civilisations (lifestyle, religion, art), focusing on the civilisation from the Indus Valley.</p>  | | <p>Settlements</p> <p>This term we will be learning about settlements. Children will extend their knowledge on what a settlement is and how many different types of settlements there are.</p>  | |

| <p>The Twits by Roald Dahl</p> <p>Children will use this book to write diaries, instructions, narratives, newspaper reports and information leaflets.</p>  | <p>Developing singing technique</p> <p>This half term children will be developing their singing technique based on the theme of Vikings. This will include learning to keep in time and work on musical notation and rhythm as well as using actions to perform a song.</p>  | <p>Caring friendships and Respect</p> <p>As part of their RSE learning this term, children will be exploring how to be respectful with each other, how words can be hurtful and what is considered a healthy and an unhealthy relationship.</p>  | <p>Weaving</p> <p>In Art this term, children will be learning about weaving. They will know what a mood board is, and create one. They will know and understand the process of tie-dyeing, and what warp and weft is in weaving. They will create a final piece and evaluate it.</p>  | <p>PE day: Tuesday</p> <p>Gymnastics</p> <p>This term, children will develop their gymnastics skills. games. They will learn how to balance and perform different types of rolls as well as jumping, rocking and rolling on mats.</p>  | |
